1. The Independent State of Papua New Guinea has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of Sustainable Highlands Highway Investment Program Tranche 2. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contracts named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
2. The **National Procurement Commission** on behalf of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea ("the Employer") invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the above contract packages. Performance Based Road Maintenance Works mainly consist of maintenance activities necessary for keeping the Roads in compliance with specified Performance Standards or Service Levels after completion of Initial Repairs.

3. **National competitive bidding** will be conducted in accordance with ADB's Single Stage: One Envelope bidding procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.
4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications defined in the Bidding Document may participate in this bidding:
 - (i) Pending litigation shall not represent more than 50% of the bidder's net worth.
 - (ii) The Bidder's net worth for the last year, calculated as the difference between total assets and total liabilities should be positive.
 - (iii) Average Annual Construction Turnover (AACT) within the last three years, Financial Resources less its financial obligations for its current contract commitments and Construction Experience within the last five years as given in the table below.

5. The Bidder shall submit with its Bid the following additional documents:

- (i) A copy of current IPA Certificate of Incorporation as evidence to comply with company registration laws and in evidence of valid business operations.
- (ii) A copy of valid Certificate of Compliance (COC)
- (iii) A copy of Tax Identification Number (TIN) Certification.

All the above requirements are to be complied with by the national bidders at the time of submission of bids. International Bidders can submit the documents at the time of bid submission if available or before contract finalization.
