Instructions to Bidders

- Bidders must arrange with their Agent (s) or a Courier firm of their choice to pick up tender documents and a similar arrangement must be made for the lodgement of their bid (s).
- Bidders must address the outer envelope containing their bid with the address as indicated above in the Bid Delivery Place and marked with the tender number, description of the project, closing date, and time.
- Bidders must provide copies of their current IPA certificate of incorporation as evidence of complying
 with company registration laws, all companies must provide copies of IRC Certificates plus
 consolidated statements of accounts, and all bidders must provide Industrial Contractors Certificate
 from the Department of Commence & Industry (DCI)
- All bidders must provide their current social obligations certificate such as employer membership to NASFUND or Nambawan Superannuation.
- Any payments of Bid Document Purchase or Bid Security made payable to the National Procurement Commission Bid Refund Trust Account. Account Number 7018 10 0276, Bank South Pacific, Port Moresby (Down Town)
- A Bank Guarantee specified in the Tender Document made payable to the National Procurement Commission will be required as a performance security and advance payment against the contract.
- The National Procurement Commission will not be held liable for any mishandling.
- In accordance with National Procurement Act (amended 2021), Section 48 National Preservation and Restrictions. (3)

A Procurement -

- a) With a value estimated by the Commission of up to K10,000,000.00, shall have a technical evaluation requirement that is open to public tender only for National companies and citizens with the capacity to undertake or provide the goods, works, or services; and
- b) With a value estimated by the Commission of greater than K10,000,000.00 but less than K50,000,000.00 shall have the technical evaluation requirement that is open to public tender only
 - So that at least 50 percent of the value of the procurement is to be undertaken by national companies and citizens, with the capacity to undertake or provide the goods, works, or services; or
 - ii. In the case of a partnership, 50 percent of the partnership is held by national companies and citizens with the capacity to undertake or provide the goods, works, or services; and
- c) With a value estimated by the Commission of equal to or greater than K50, 000,000.00 shall have a technical

evaluation requirement that is open to public tender by all companies and persons.
