1. The National Procurement Commission, on behalf of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea, invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for an Electronic Government Procurement (e-GP) in four lots for the National Procurement Commission funded by the Government of Papua New Guinea (GoPNG).
2. Bidding will be conducted through competitive procurement using a Request for Proposals (RFP), a two-envelope system with rated criteria, without prequalification as specified in the National Procurement Act, 2018 as amended, and is open to all eligible Bidders.
3. Proposals will be evaluated in accordance with the evaluation process set out in the bidding documents.
4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from and inspect the bidding document during office hours at the address given below.
5. The bidding document in English may be requested by interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of PGK5,000.00. The method of payment and other details are presented in the table below. The document will only be available in digital format and sent by email.
6. Proposals must be delivered to the address below on or before June 15, 2026, 17:00 pm local PNG time. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. The outer Bid envelopes marked "ORIGINAL BID" and the inner envelopes marked "TECHNICAL PART" will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend, at the address below on June 16, 2026 @ 11:00 am local time. All envelopes marked "FINANCIAL PART" shall remain unopened

and will be held in safe custody by the National Procurement Commission until the second Public Bid Opening.

7. All Bids must be accompanied by a "Bid-Securing Declaration".
